INTRODUCTION:

Ms. Karin O'Brien Cubbage, Owner, is requesting a variance from the Building Code Requirements for a Drinking Fountain. The subject property is located at 100 East Commerce Street and is zoned C-2 Highway Commercial.

BACKGROUND:

On May 20, 2014, the Board of Aldermen adopted the 2012 International Code Council Series, Building Codes in a unanimous vote of approval. The codes adopted include the 2012 International Plumbing Code.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. The applicant is relocating Area 51 Ice Cream to the 100 East Commerce Street address for the manufacturing and sale of ice cream which necessitated a remodeling of the existing building.
- 2. After review of the construction plan submittal, revisions were submitted to address review comments.
- 3. Building Permit 2020-3838 was issued upon construction plan approval.
- 4. The project has passed all inspections up to this point in time.
- 5. The most recent inspection passed for the building was the framing which will allow the installation of dry wall. The next inspection will be the above ceiling inspection.

STAFF COMMENTS:

- 1. The Applicant's request for the variance is included in the attached information.
- 2. The Building Official's review comments are included and includes a note to the requirement of a drinking fountain according to the adopted Plumbing Code.
- 3. The Applicant's response to the Building Official's comments is included.

- 4. A copy of the original plan and revised plan showing the location of a drinking fountain are included.
- 5. Chapter 4 of the 2012 Plumbing Code addresses the requirements of drinking fountains and is included with the applicable sections highlighted.
 - a. Section 403 covers the minimum plumbing facility requirements and includes Table 403.1 which directs the number of required fixtures.
 - b. Section 410 directly covers drinking fountains.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

In order to be consistent with enforcement of the building codes that have been adopted by the City, Staff recommendation is for denial of the variance request.







Mr. Hill stated that his water bill was \$714.00. It's a new home in FieldBrook, I though maybe it was a leak. We were told 74,000 was used. If it was a 1 inch water line, 1,000 gallons can go through it in an hour. We didn't water that much. A neighbor stated that a builder was watering all day and sometimes at night, before I took ownership. I don't think I took that meter at 2,000 gallons. When I called, I spoke to Tom, he said there was nothing he could do. I paid a day late, got charged a late charge and then a fee to pay with my card.
