EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A brief discussion was held about the City's water and sewer systems, that they are operating well and that in the event of a power failure, Entergy advised that those facilities will be a priority. The Board discussed the likely need for adjustments, and there are issues with frozen pipes. Alderwoman Lynch inquired about the length, and was advised it will be for 30 days or less. Mayor Ferguson advised the Board that he would keep them informed of any major expenses incurred during the State of Emergency.

Motion was duly made by Alderman Higdon and seconded by Alderman Hobbs to declare a temporary State of Emergency for the City of Hernando due to the extreme Winter Weather Conditions. A vote was taken with the following results:
