RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF CITY OF HERNANDO, MISSISSIPPI, GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM AD VALOREM TAXES

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Hernando, Mississippi (the "Board") took up for consideration the matter of granting to New Age Logistics, Inc. ("New Age"), Associated Wholesale Grocers, Inc. ("AWG") and Valu Merchandisers Company ("VMC" together with New Age and AWG, the "Applicants"), an exemption from all ad valorem taxes to the fullest extent permitted by Mississippi law on all personal property held by Applicants in a licensed free

port warehouse for storage in transit to a final destination outside the State of Mississippi, and the following Resolution, having first been reduced to writing was introduced:

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HERNANDO, MISSISSIPPI, GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM AD VALOREM TAXES TO THE FULL EXTENT PERMITTED BY MISSISSIPPI LAW TO NEW AGE LOGISTICS, INC., WHOLESALE GROCERS, INC. AND VALU MERCHANDISERS COMPANY, OWNERS OF THE LICENSED FREE PORT WAREHOUSE OR PROPERTY HELD IN THE WAREHOUSE, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 27-31-53 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE (1972), AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, New Age is a Missouri corporation qualified to do business in Mississippi. AWG is a Kansas corporation qualified to do business in the State of Mississippi. VMC is a Kansas corporation qualified to do business in the State of Mississippi. New Age and VMC are each a wholly-owned subsidiary of AWG. The Applicants' headquarters are located in Kansas City, Kansas:

WHEREAS, the Board, acting for and on behalf of the City of Hernando, Mississippi ("City"), has negotiated in good faith with the AWG and VMC as to the issuance of a free port warehouse license pursuant to Section 27-31-51(2) and (3) of the Mississippi Code (the "Free Port Licenses") and the ad valorem tax exemptions requested by the Applicants as authorized by Section 27-31-53 of the Mississippi Code, as amended, and related Mississippi statutes (the "Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption");

WHEREAS, New Age, as a wholly-owned subsidiary of AWG, is constructing in the City and DeSoto County, Mississippi (the "County") an automated grocery distribution warehouse facility (the "Facility");

WHEREAS, the Facility will include a warehouse, related facilities, and other structures, places or areas that will be operated by New Age for the temporary storage or handling of personal property pending its distribution and shipment to become inventory at retail grocery stores ("Facility Inventories"). AWG is expected to own all or a portion of the Facility Inventories. From time to time, VMC may own a portion of the Facility Inventories. All or a substantial portion of the Facility Inventories will be shipped to destinations outside the State of Mississippi ("Out-of-State Inventories");

WHEREAS, Applicants shall file with the DeSoto County Tax Assessor its 2023 personal property rendition and its 2023 free port warehouse report of inventory;

WHEREAS, Applicants have applied for an exemption for its inventory consigned or transferred to the Facility within DeSoto County, Mississippi (the "Application") and have certified in the Application that New Age is the owner of the Facility and that AWG and VMC ship personal property to destinations outside of the State of Mississippi each year and AWG and VMC are qualified to apply for the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption;

WHEREAS, Applicants (including New Age out of an abundance of caution as the Facility owner) are qualified to make application for exemption from ad valorem taxes pursuant to Section 27-31-53 of the Mississippi Code (1972), as amended;

WHEREAS, the Board agrees that it should exercise its discretionary authority to exempt from all ad valorem taxes the Out-of-State Inventories in the Facility from January 1, 2023 and to continue for as long as the Facility is in operation ("Term");

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2020, as provided in the Memorandum of Understanding with New Age (the "MOU"), the Board, the County, and the Tax Assessor of the County entered into an Ad Valorem Tax Agreement ("Tax Agreement") with New Age granting a fee-in-lieu abatement of ad valorem taxes on both real property and personal property within the City;

WHERAS, the Tax Agreement specifically granted a fee-in-lieu abatement to Facility Inventories not shipped out of state and therefore not eligible for the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption (the "FIL Abatement");

WHEREAS, under Mississippi law and the terms of the MOU and the Tax Agreement, partial assignment is permitted, and as a result, New Age has partially assigned to AWG and VMC the Tax Agreement as the same may apply to Facility Inventories not subject to the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption;

That the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption shall be granted automatically and without the necessity of any further or additional official action by the Board, beginning on January 1, 2023 and continuing for the Term which shall exempt the Applicants' otherwise taxable Out-of-State Inventories located in the Facility from all ad valorem taxes, including City taxes and those school district taxes which the Board is authorized to exempt.
- 6. That the Applicants' Out-of-State Inventories which are subject to the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption:
 - (a) shall not be deemed to have acquired a situs in this State for the purpose of ad valorem taxes;
 - (b) shall not be deprived of the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption because they are bound, divided, broken in bulk, labeled, relabeled, or repackaged while in the Facility; and
 - (c) are exempt from all ad valorem taxation, including ad valorem taxes for school district purposes, commencing on January 1, 2023 and extending for the Term.
- 7. That the DeSoto County Tax Assessor take all actions in preparation of the tax rolls necessary and appropriate to implement such Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption granted to the Applicants, including making appropriate notations on the tax rolls so the Out-of-State Inventories will be treated as provided for in the resolution/order of the Board approving this Application and the issuance of the joint Free Port Licenses.
- 8. That the Clerk of the Board is directed to record the Application, together with a copy of this resolution of the Board approving the Application, in the Minutes of the Board and to forward a certified transcript of such approval by the Board of both the Free Port Licenses for the Facility and the Application for the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption, including a copy of the resolution approving the Application, to the DeSoto County Tax Assessor.
- 9. That consent is given to a partial assignment of the Tax Agreement to AWG and VMC to allow for the ad valorem exemption contemplated in the Tax Agreement to also apply to AWG and VMC for those Facility Inventories owned by them and not subject to the Joint Free Port Warehouse Exemption.

INTRODUCTION:

Mr. Lloyd Miller, Jr., representing Winningham Estates, L.L.C., is requesting Final Plat Approval for Winningham Estates Subdivision, Section "D," consisting of 26 single-family residential lots, located west of Andy's Way, and west of Miller's Way, in Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 8 West.

BACKGROUND:

Winningham Estates Subdivision was recommended for rezoning from the "AR," Agricultural Residential District" to "PUD," Planned Unit Development District by the Planning Commission on February 7, 2005, and subsequently by the Board of Aldermen on March 15, 2005.

Phase B – 42 Residential Lots, 1 Common Open Space Lot Recorded – January 31, 2017 – Plat Book 134, Pages 42-43

DISCUSSION:

The proposed subdivision will be developed as Winningham Estates Subdivision, Section "D," and will consist of 26 residential lots The minimum lot size for the development established in the approved project text is 10,000 sq. ft. The residential lot sizes in Section "D" range from 14,000 sq. ft. up to 26,000 sq. ft.

Access into Section "D" will be provided by the construction of two new streets, stubbing from the existing Andy's Way and Miller's Way.

Each lot will have the required setbacks listed below which conform to the approved Planned Unit Development and the Restrictive Covenants requirements.

Front30	feet
Side15	feet total
Rear25	feet

The minimum heated floor area requirement for the Winningham Estates Subdivision is 1,800 sq. ft. for all homes. One and one-half and two-story homes must have a minimum of 1,500 sq. ft. on the first floor. All homes must be a minimum of 75% brick exterior with a two-car completely enclosed garage.

Section "A" of Winningham Estates was developed by Brad Sidle and Ken Gresham doing business as Winningham Development, L.L.C. Lloyd Miller, Jr., doing business as Winningham Estates, L.L.C. purchased the remaining lots and undeveloped acreage, and subsequently developed Section "B and C"

STAFF COMMENTS:

- 1. This proposal substantially conforms to that of the preliminary submittal.
- 2. Since the recording of Phase B, a construction entrance has been built, providing access to the active part of the development.
- 3. The Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve this application

A copy of the finalized incorporation papers and all deeds transferring common elements to the Homeowners Association shall be submitted to the staff for inclusion in the file. All common elements required in all previous sections of the development must be completed and dedicated to the Homeowners Association prior to the issuance of any building permits in Section "D"
- 2. The Homeowners Association covenants shall be submitted to and approved by Planning Staff prior to recording of the plat for Section "D" The submitted covenants shall match the covenants that were recorded with Section "C" of Winningham Estates Subdivision. If amendments are requested by the developer, if the proposed changes are more restrictive than what is currently required by the previous phases of Winningham Estates Subdivision, then those changes may be approved by the Planning staff. If the proposed changes are less restrictive than what is currently required by the previous phases of Winningham Estates Subdivision, then those changes must be approved by the Planning Commission.

- 3. Improvements are to be the responsibility of the developer and not the responsibility of the City of Hernando.
- 4. All landscaping in all common open space areas, natural areas, buffer areas, streetscape areas, medians, islands, and the entrance signage areas and such other associated improvements shall be installed/constructed prior to the issuance of any building permit within that respective phase of the development. Street trees may be bonded insuring their installation prior to the final inspection and occupancy of the residence upon each lot.
- Following Plat Approval, the Developer shall submit two (2) complete sets of construction
 plans for review and approval to the Office of Planning. Grading, drainage, and
 engineering construction plans to be approved by the City Engineer and Public Works
 Director.
- 6. PUBLIC HEARING - FOOD TRUCK ORDINANCE.

Public Hearing was opened by Mayor Johnson.

Austin Cardosi stated he received comments and an ordinance mark up from Kit Kitchens. Restaurants do not see enough restrictions in the preliminary ordinance. There were some responses that the ordinance would be too restrictive. There were not many public responses and those will be sent to the board for review.

Alderman Miller stated we should as a board make sure we look after our brick-and-mortar businesses. The expense they incur and also employees they have support the community. They are afraid to speak out on this issue and made a substantial investment. Costs have gone up for them. If we have food trucks, I see our brick-and-mortar businesses closing. We must support our businesses.

Alderman Piper stated his grandparents had a restaurant for 31 years and that was their everything. There is certainly competitive issue with food trucks, and they are able to move around. The community seems to want them for special occasions and promotions. Enforcement will be difficult.

Alderman Wicker stated maybe have a 150 ft buffer. 66-119A states you can only set up 5 times a month. The fee is \$250.00 per year, and I would like to see the fee at \$500.00 per year.

Alderman Harris stated he would hate to look out of my restaurant and see a food truck parked there taking my customers. One thing that gives me heartburn is there is a food truck that sets up across the street from the tennis courts on Commerce Street. There are 4 restaurants in that area, and I don't think that's right. I think we need them at the Farmers Market and Concessions at the ball fields. I think there is a place for them. Think of our restaurants first.

Austin Cardosi stated some cities have a designated spot they can go.

Mayor Johnson stated that mom and pop restaurants close on Sunday and Monday, maybe we could look at that.

Alderwoman Ross questioned that the ordinance was too restrictive? What was too restrictive, the 5 days a month? I think we should raise the fee to \$500.00 a year and I do like the idea of a designated location.

Alderwoman Lynch stated she does like the buffer idea, and we should keep that.

Alderman Wicker stated Conger Park would be a good location, but Alderman Miller questioned the parking issue.

Austin Cardosi stated he will come back with more ideas at the next meeting.

Jon Stevenson 1589 Johnston Rd, Hernando, spoke as a restaurant owner and as a brick-and-mortar establishment. The increase in costs is hard and we pay property tax that the food trucks do not pay. We have to keep our restaurants up, pave parking lots, etc. that they do not have to do. I like designated districts. I am for competition as long as it is fair competition. When parked in parking spaces that are zoned specifically that business, where will the brick-and-mortar customers park? This causes traffic issues. It needs to be more restrictive than it is. Please consider this as factor in your deliberations.
