WHEREAS, said Project has now been completed according to the provisions of said resolutions to proceed therewith, and the Governing Body of the City, at a regular meeting, determined and declared the cost thereof allocable to the properties benefitted, and such cost having been entered into the Assessment Book for Local Improvements as the assessments levied against each lot or piece of property benefitted; and

WHEREAS, notice was duly published as provided by law notifying the parties in interest to appear and file objections, if any, to the proposed assessments at a meeting of the Governing Body of the City to be held at 6:00 o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, September 19, 2023, at the City Hall at Hernando, Mississippi; which date was more than fifteen (15) days from the date of the first publication of said notice, as more fully appears by reference to the affidavit of publication on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, no objections or protests were filed on or before said date to any of the proposed assessments by the owners of the properties benefitted, and the matter came on for final consideration at this meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City now finds and determines that each and every requirement of the statutes of the State of Mississippi and ordinances and resolutions of the City have been strictly complied with, and that all conditions precedent to the validity of such assessments against properties benefitted by the Project have been complied with according to

law, and the Governing Body of the City now has full jurisdiction and authority to approve and make said assessments final; and

WHEREAS, the assessments to each property are allocated as follows:

Section 1. That the assessments against the properties benefitted by the special capital sewer improvement to serve the Hernando West project as the same may appear in the Assessment Roll for such project in the Assessment Book for Local Improvements in the City of Hernando, be and the same are hereby approved, confirmed, and made final as therein set forth, and from this date shall constitute a lien upon the respective lots or parcels of lands and other real property upon which they are levied, superior to all other liens except those for state and county taxes.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.

Dear Colonel Klein:

The City of Hernando is embarking on a program to reduce the quantities of infiltration and inflow (I&I) into its wastewater collection and conveyance system (WCCS). Uncontrolled groundwater infiltration and rainwater inflow in the WCCS can have detrimental effects on social, economic, and environmental aspects of urban areas. This project serves as an initial step towards the overall goal of reducing the impact of I&I by repairing deficiencies within the WCCS. This project will locate sources of I&I in the City's sewer mains as well as among the private property sewer laterals. By utilizing the funds for this project, the City will be able to identify, correct, repair, and eliminate sources of I&I.

The effect of the I&I problem is experienced system wide from the 'beginning of the pipe' to the 'end of pipe' throughout the network. The I&I issue overwhelms the collection system during rain events and wet weather seasons, taxing the pumping capacities of its lift stations, the abilities of the gravity system, and the overall treatment capacity at the wastewater treatment plants (WWTP). Though a source of I&I may be located in one sewer basin, the effect of that source is felt in the subsequent basins downstream and eventually impacting the WWTPs.

The overburden of the system because of the I&I flow quantities is causing sanitary sewer overflows which present an overall health safety risk to the public, potential property damage, contamination of state waters, local business, and facility downtime, and resulting in non-compliance issues for the City under the EPA's Clean Water Act.

This proposed project will impact approximately 16,000 people either by reducing future sewer rate increases, interruption of service, and environmental/health issues. The total project cost will not be known with any certainty until the complete inspection of the sewer lines in the expected areas of (I/I). Therefore, it is anticipated that this project will require phasing and the first phase request is \$3,000,000 to include internal survey of the sewer lines and manholes, and begin repairs identified from the survey.

I request that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg District, undertake an environmental infrastructure project under the authority of Section 592 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1999. The City of Hernando hereby expresses our willingness to serve as the sponsor.

I understand that under this authority, the Corps can provide cost-shared project-specific design and construction assistance associated with water-related environmental infrastructure and resource protection and development for publicly owned projects. We are capable of fulfilling our financial obligation; in general, providing 25 percent of the total project costs; including furnishing lands, easements, rights-of-way, relocations, and disposal areas, and we will operate and maintain the project upon completion.

We are also aware that both the Corps and our responsibilities will be delineated in the Project Partnership Agreement, which both parties will execute before construction commences.

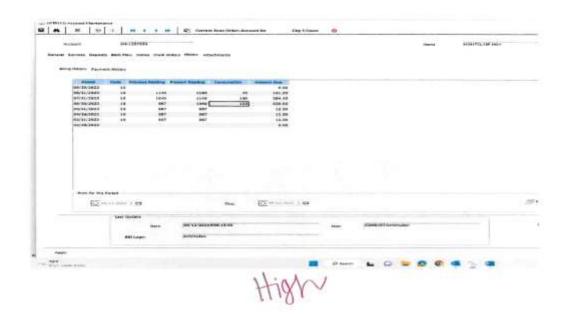
